T-Shirt Design Contest

The **Florida Solar Energy Center (FSEC)** now called the **FSEC Energy Research Center**, launched EnergyWhiz to educate students, teachers and the public about its research and to encourage students to explore renewable energy technologies and energy efficiency concepts. **EnergyWhiz** is a celebration of student ingenuity and a showcase of the projects students have created that use renewable energy and energy efficient technologies to solve real world problems. RULES

Entries: Entries are limited to ONE SUBMISSION PER TEAM (a team consists of 1-6 people).

Eligibility: Grades K-12 and College students are eligible to submit t-shirt designs.

Fee: FREE! Register at: www.fsec.ucf.go/ewreg/

Design: Your creation MUST include or incorporate the word “EnergyWhiz” in the design. It may also include the words, “FSEC Energy Research Center” in the design.

- ◇ Only original artwork will be considered.
- ◇ Artwork must be submitted electronically. The winner will be required to provide a high resolution image for printing if one wasn't originally submitted (i.e. 300 ppi @ desired print size or as vector graphics). Acceptable formats include: PDF, JPEG, AI, EPS, SVG, PSD, PNG, TIFF.

Submitting your entry: Email your entry to Susan@fsec.ucf.edu along with the name of your school/college or organization, list of team member names and grade levels, as well as a few sentences that explain your team’s t-shirt concept.

Judging: A team of judges will review entries based on the following criteria (40 points maximum):

- ◇ *Appeal to multiple audiences - 10 points.*
- ◇ *Creative artwork and idea - 10 points.*
- ◇ *Attractiveness and neatness of layout - 10 points.*
- ◇ *Overall Impact on delivering the EnergyWhiz message - 10 points.*

Award: The winning designer(s) will be announced at the 2021 EnergyWhiz awards ceremony on May 7. Each winning team member will receive an award certificate, medallion, and recognition on the 2021 EnergyWhiz event website.

Final design: The FSEC Energy Research Center reserves the right to alter the final design for printing. All submissions become the property of the FSEC Energy Research Center. No entries will be returned.
